 4. Submission of an entry confirms the granting of permission by the author for the
sequence to be shown in public.
 5. Entries are restricted to a **maximum of 2 per entrant**. A separate entry form is
required for each sequence.
 6. **Closing date:** Entry forms must reach the organizers by: **Friday 6th February 2009**
 7. Completed entry forms should be returned through your club's member on the NIPA

 8. **All CDs must be in the hands of the organizers by Friday 6th February 2009.**
This is so that sequences may be loaded onto the hard drive of the festival computer and
so that any technical hitches may be sorted out beforehand.

- Slide-sound sequences must be with the organizers by 10.00 a.m. on Saturday 21st February.** The organisers will be responsible for all projection on Imatronic systems.
Free Head pulsing will be catered for if required.
9. The decision of the organisers shall be final and binding. Submission of an entry confirms
that the entrant has read and accepted the foregoing in all respects.
 10. **Digital entries** – A digital projector, computer (Windows platform) and a sound system
will be provided. The entrant must submit a CD containing an .EXE programme, i.e. the
sequence must run with no additional software requirements. There should only be one
sequence per CD, which should be indelibly labelled. The sequence should be
programmed with no “run box”, and to return to the desktop at the end. All CDs will be
copied to the hard drive for projection at the Festival. Copied material will be erased
immediately following the Festival, and the CD returned, unless other arrangements have
